



He returned to Australia aboard the transport Ypringa, disembarking on 1st January 1920, receiving his discharge on 1 February 1920. In recognition of his service he was awarded the 1914-18 Star, the British War Medal and the Victory Medal. Marr Hilda May SIMCOCK 1921. Educ Dec 1932, Diploma of Public Administration, Adelaide University. 100 He had previously completed courses toward the degree of Batchelor of Engineering, passing two subjects in 1924 and a further two in 1926. 


